





## Main Street Pedestrian Safety Improvements:

- Numerous pedestrian safety issues/concerns expressed by downtown BID and business operators
- Work group convened to discuss ideas and options for improvements (see next page)
- Consensus reached around one of several options identified as potential solutions.
- Design work and public input needed to refine the end product.



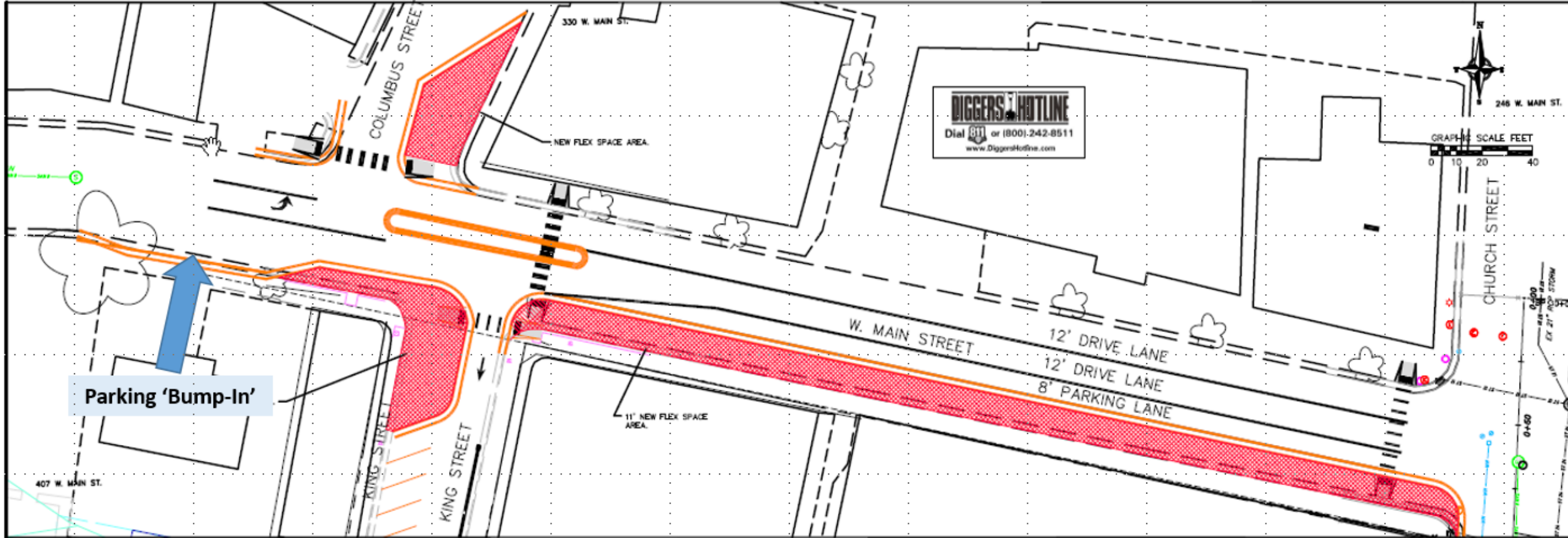


# SAFETY CONCERN RAISED DOWNTOWN



- 1. Offset intersection at Main and Columbus/King Streets.
  - Visibility, difficult turning movements
  - Drivers making risky decisions
- 2. Crosswalk at Main and King Street.
  - Visibility of and by pedestrians
  - Cars bypassing left turning vehicles
- 3. Travel speeds along Main.
  - Exacerbated by COVID pandemic
- 4. U-Turns on Main Street
- 5. Bank Drive-Thru.
  - Exiting vehicles turning left
  - Use of drive-thru lanes to access parking lot
- 6. Very narrow sidewalk along south side of Main Street





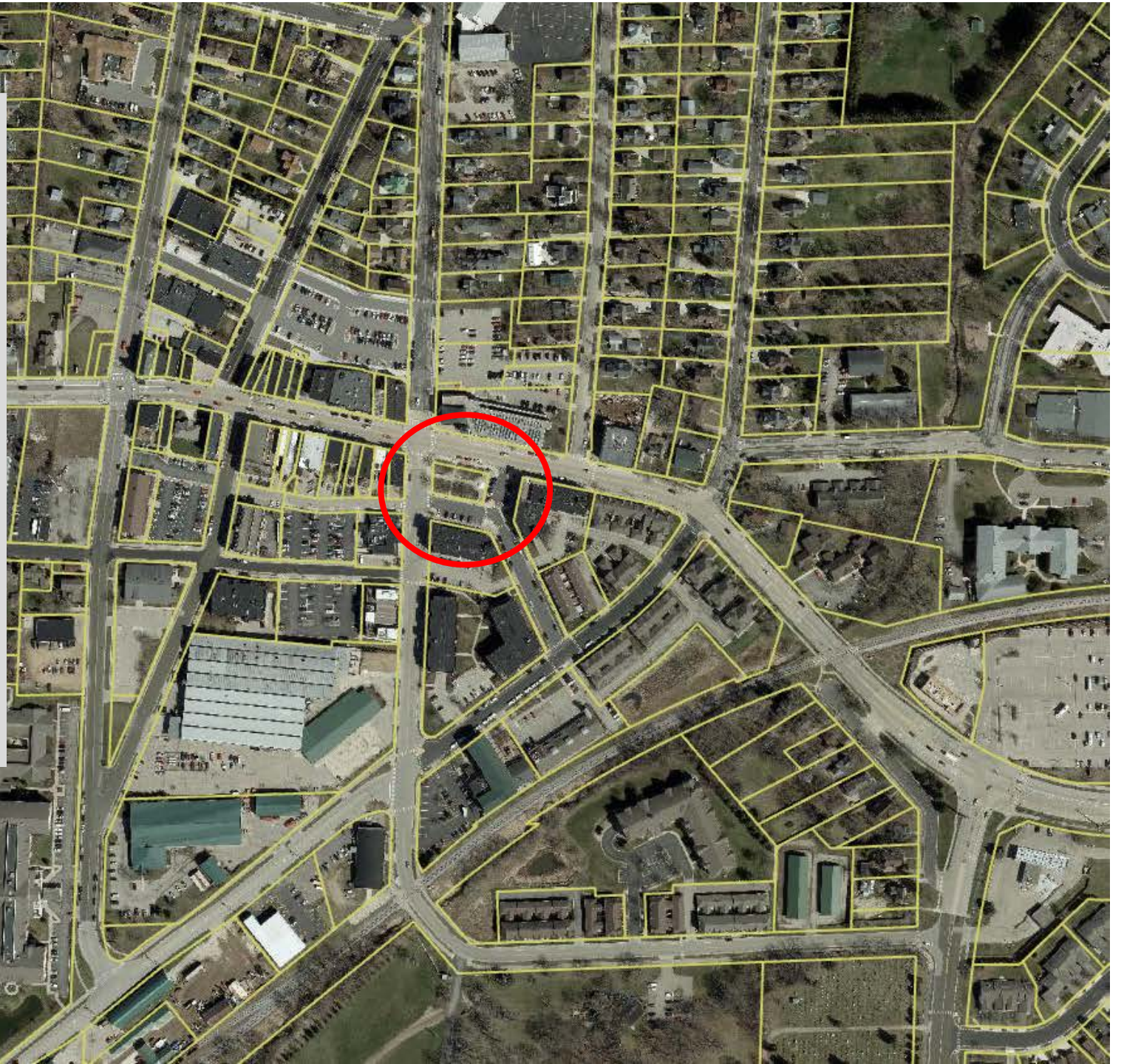


## Cannery Square:

- Constructed in 2003
- Fountain maintenance
- Electrical Issues
- Pavers/tree grate issues
- 2023 Funds for repairs

However:

- There is a desire by many to alter the space – more usable for events.
- Consider alternative fountain solutions.
- Lighting upgrades, etc.





## Potential Scope of Work:

- Public engagement – conceptual plan for reinventing the space.
- Evaluation of current needs and what short term repairs and maintenance work should be completed.
- No detailed construction plans, but good detail on things like surface treatments, planting areas, fountain or no fountain, public art, lighting, etc. to guide a future redevelopment of the plaza.







## Festival Street:

- Recommendation in the Sun Prairie Stronger Plan
- Connects Downtown to Bank of Sun Prairie Stadium
- Redevelopment of sites along the street is underway.
- Vision is a shared-mode street that provides for all modes on most days, but that can be closed to vehicle traffic for events, parades, etc.
- Rough concept and vision is shown in the SP Stronger Plan.
- It is time to take the next step and design these improvements.
